PROPOSAL DEVELOPMENT

The Geneva Foundation provides proposal development support to researchers in the areas of federal grants, federal contracts, and industry sponsored clinical trials. Geneva supports the researcher by providing tailored funding searches and opportunity leads; facilitating the development of the proposal; preparing all ancillary items, supporting documents, and budgets; providing a full review of the research plan; and submitting a strong, competitive proposal prior to the deadline.

FEDERAL RESEARCH PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

Geneva currently manages research programs worldwide, which include federally funded and industry funded research grants, federal contracts, cooperative agreements, multi-center clinical trials, congressional special interest programs, and multi-center research consortiums. Geneva works closely with the researcher and research team to manage contract changes; recruit and hire qualified staff; administer individual study budgets; provide monthly budget reporting; procure supplies and equipment; submit required reports to sponsors; and initiate and monitor subcontracts, resulting in a robust and compliant program from start to finish. Geneva maintains in-house travel and procurement teams dedicated to providing personalized and knowledgeable support to the investigator.

FEDERAL CONTRACT MANAGEMENT

Geneva provides program and contract management on federal contract awards, including multisite domestic and international programs. Our federal contract portfolio includes stand-alone individual vehicles and indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (ID/IQ) contracts with large, diverse teams of partners. Geneva has the capability to act as the prime contractor or the subcontractor depending on the needs of the program and what will result in the best solution for the customer.

CLINICAL TRIALS

Geneva has demonstrated success in managing researcher-initiated and industry-sponsored clinical trials within large military medical sites.
