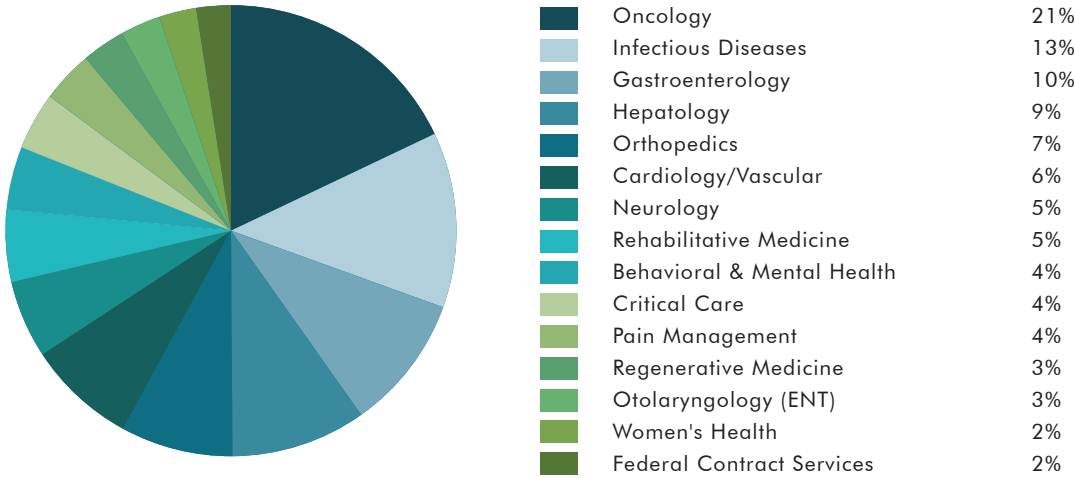

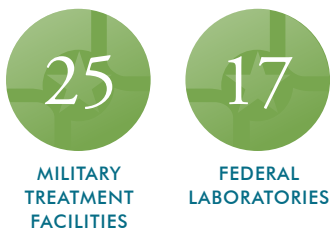
TOP 15 RESEARCH AREAS BY NUMBER OF PROGRAMS:



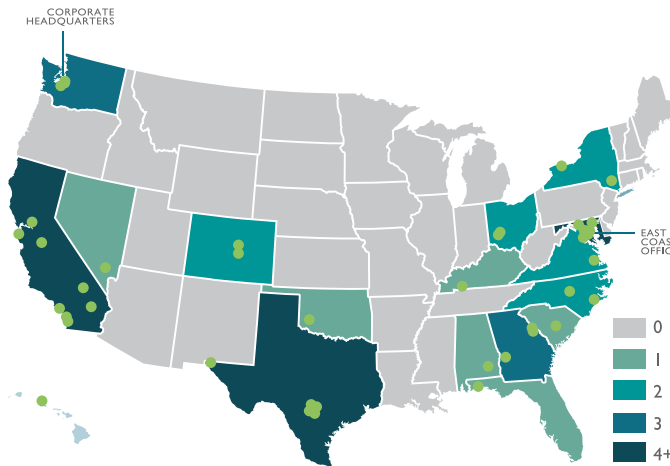
