FBRI Executive Director LTC (Ret.) Stephen M. DeLellis is a decorated military veteran, having served more than 35 years in the U.S. Army. His background includes a variety of military medical positions, including Special Forces Medic, Physician Assistant, and Chief of Medical Training in the U.S Army Special Operations Command (USASOC). He culminated his military career as the USASOC Deputy Command Surgeon.

LTC (Ret.) DeLellis's medical career has been dedicated to understanding the effects of traumatic brain injury (TBI) in service members and veterans. In conjunction with Womack Army Medical Center and several universities, he helped to develop one of the most comprehensive neurocognitive baseline and post-injury assessment programs in the Department of Defense.

Among his many military awards and decorations, Steve was recognized for his TBI work as an Army Medical Specialist Corps' Iron Major in 2012, inducted into the Order of Military Merit in 2018, and was the Army recipient of the Henry M. Jackson Foundation's Hero of Military Medicine award in 2019.

Steve is excited to continue serving the military community and the war fighter in his role as the Executive Director of the Fort Bragg Research Institute.
