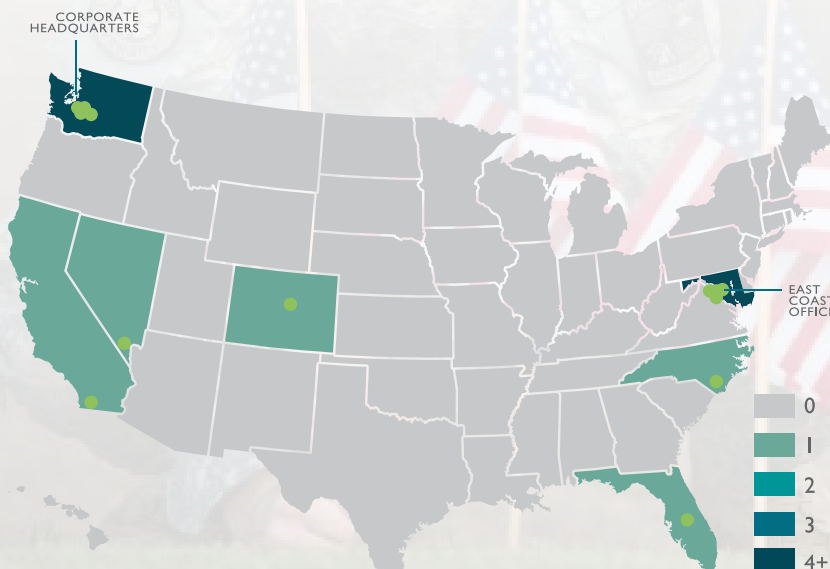

Geneva's Community Giving Program provides funding to support military and medical events, including specific military medical activities that are not included in departmental budgets or in instances when the department does not have existing reserve funds at Geneva. The program supports an array of events, ranging from community health fairs, to continuing educational trainings at military treatment facilities and federal laboratories nationwide. If support is awarded, Geneva will work directly with facility gifting or the legal office to process the award within current federal guidelines and regulations.

## PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Geneva accepts applications on a rolling basis, but applications must be received at least four months prior to the activity start date. Please note that applications that are not submitted before the four-month deadline or incomplete applications may not be considered. The applicant will be notified via email correspondence within three weeks of application receipt regarding support decision.
- Geneva has the discretion to award funds less than or equal to (but not higher than) the amount requested on the application. If awarded, funds must be utilized for the specific event (including event date listed on the application) and items on the application. If funds are not fully utilized for the event or if the event is canceled, the funds must be returned to Geneva.
- After the Geneva-supported activity has taken place, it is requested that a Community Giving Program Evaluation Form is completed. If an Evaluation Form is not submitted, Geneva holds the right to not consider future applications.
- Geneva typically awards between \$500 and \$2,000 and will only award funding if reserve funds with Geneva are not available to be gifted.
